Upcoming work

From December 2018 to January 2019, the following construction activities are expected to be carried out:


- » Internal strip out works in Wharf 4/5 will continue with the ground floor and level one. This is expected to be completed around April 2019.
- » Investigation works to aid construction will continue. This will involve site inspections and specialised surveying.

The project has approved noise limits for the above activities. Work will be carried out within the approved construction hours of Monday to Friday: 7am – 6pm and Saturday: 8am – 1pm.

The project team actively monitors construction noise on site. Monitoring to date has shown no noise exceedances.

The site will be closed from Saturday 22 December 2018 to Sunday 6 January 2019.
